Motion for Council to Consider: Request a staff report to implement a permanent and/or mobile Surveillance Camera system as a pilot project for public spaces with Farrell Street Park Pathway in Dartmouth being the location of the pilot project due to recent criminal activity in the area.	
Reason: A recent homicide in the area; and, results of the October 7, 2015 CEPTED Audit, necessitates the urgency in reviewing all aspects of providing security measures to ensure public safety for all HRM owned/leased public space properties.	
Outcome Sought: Staff recommendation report to initiate a Surveillance Camera Pilot Project, permanent and/or mobile system, for public spaces; with, Farrell Street Park Pathway being the location for the pilot project.
