<b>Subject: Recommendations to the current Provincial Aid to Municipality Program</b>		
<b>Motion for Regional Council to Consider:</b>		
<p>That Halifax Regional Council request a staff report to reassess and make possible recommendations to the current Provincial Aid to Municipality Program for the cost-share paving of subdivision streets Outside the Urban Core area.</p> <p>The report ought to address the current program and the petition process and compare it to the recently revised Urban Core Paving program whereby the municipality has waived the right of petition and offers a 2/3 - 1/3 cost share between HRM and the Property owners.</p> <p>With respect to the Provincial program, the cost sharing could be amended to keep the 1/2 from the Province, but adjust the remaining balance to 1/3 from property owners &amp; 1/6 from HRM.</p> <p>Also, the right of petition would be waived and there ought to be closer collaboration with the Province to coordinate opportunities of possible synergy of tying in with Provincial paving projects with local upgrading of subdivision streets.</p> <p>Also, the Classification of Street type can be expanded beyond only Class J to include Class G, H &amp; I as potential cost-shared Assessable Streets with the Aid to Municipality Program.</p>		
<b>Reason:</b>		
<p>To ensure that residents outside the urban core have the benefit of a program to make it easier to access the Provincial Aid to Municipality Program.</p>		
<b>Outcome Sought:</b>		
<p>That Regional Council support the motion for a staff report to reassess the Provincial Aid to Municipality Program.</p>
