Subject: HRFE Emergency Generators at Strategic HRM Locations		
<u>Motion for Regional Council to consider:</u>		
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Staff to prepare a report on capital funding needs to install emergency generators at strategic locations and an implementation plan for HRM prioritized buildings as part of a community safety and emergency management plan.2. Direct HRFE Emergency Manager to develop a strategy and priority list for emergency generators.		
<u>Reason:</u>		
<p>There are currently no HRM buildings with emergency generator backup to be used as comfort centers in the majority of areas in HRM. The average cost of a mounted and installed permanent generator is approximately \$100,000.00. This figure will change depending on how big the building is and the amount of electrical work to be completed.</p> <p>With climate change and increasing power outages in the Municipality, we are currently unprepared to provide warmth and comfort when in need to citizens.</p>		
<u>Outcome Sought:</u>		
<p>The identification and recommendation of HRM buildings by priority for the of installation of emergency generators, and the capital expenditures required by fiscal year.</p>
