Jerry Blackwood, Executive Director of Finance & Asset Management/Chief Financial Officer and Tyler Higgins, Manager, Budget & Reserves gave a presentation and responded to questions of clarification from Budget Committee.

Renée Towns, Director of Revenue, Treasurer responded to questions of clarification from Budget Committee.

THAT the motion be amended to include alternative motion 2 from the staff report dated February 22, 2023, as a new section that reads as follows:

4. Include alternative 2, a reduction of \$1 million to \$2 million to terminate and renegotiate the Taxation Agreement with Halifax International Airport Authority as outlined the Briefing Note BN069 as an option to increase revenues in the 2024/25 proposed Fiscal budget.

Cathie O'Toole, Chief Administrative Officer, Blackwood and John Traves, K.C., CD, Executive Director of Legal & Legislative Services/Municipal Solicitor responded to questions of clarification from Budget Committee regarding the negotiation process with the Halifax International Airport Authority. Traves clarified that notice of termination for the current agreement would need to be given by March 31, 2023 to take effect the following 2024/2025 fiscal year. Regional Council would also be the final decision-making body.

Councillor Morse proposed to remove 'a reduction of \$1 million to \$2 million'. As provided for in section 53 (2) of Administrative Order One, *Respecting the Procedures of the Council*, the amendment was accepted as friendly.

The motion now read:

THAT the motion be amended to include alternative motion 2 as amended, from the staff report dated February 22, 2023, as a new section that reads as follows:

4. Include alternative 2, to terminate and renegotiate the Taxation Agreement with Halifax International Airport Authority as outlined the Briefing Note BN069 as an option to increase revenues in the 2024/25 proposed Fiscal budget.

Traves and O'Toole responded to questions of clarification from Budget Committee regarding negotiation timelines and clarified there would be no financial impact on the Halifax International Airport Authority in 2023/24 fiscal year.
