The Chair confirmed that neither the property owner nor a representative was not in attendance.

Vicki Aguinaga, Compliance Officer II gave a presentation, showing photographs of the property taken on January 11, 2023, and responded to questions of clarification from the Standing Committee. Aguinaga noted they had been in contact with the property owner on January 11, 2023, and the property owner had

expressed their intent to complete the demolition. Aguinaga noted that during their inspection of the accessory structure, it was empty and there were no personal effects inside.

Tanya Phillips, Manager, By-law Standards and Karen MacDonald, Solicitor responded to questions of clarification from the Standing Committee. Phillips confirmed the property owner was provided notification of the January 12, 2023 Appeals Standing Committee meeting.

THAT the Appeals Standing Committee find the property to be dangerous or unsightly as per section 3(q) of the Charter and as per section 356 of the Charter, orders demolition of the accessory structure including but not limited to, the removal of all demolition debris, backfilling of any foundation or crawl space, and disconnecting any and all utility connections to the standard set by each respective utility service provider, so as to leave the property in a neat, tidy, environmentally compliant and safe condition within thirty (30) days after the Order is posted in a conspicuous place upon the property or personally served upon the owner. Otherwise, the Municipality will exercise its rights as set forth under Part XV (15) of the Charter.
