Direct the CAO to negotiate and execute agreements, on terms and conditions satisfactory to the CAO, and in accordance with the *Extended Producer Responsibility for Packaging, Paper Products and Packaging-Like Products* regulations with applicable Producer Responsibility Organization(s) related to the Municipality's curbside recycling collection and operation of the Municipality's Materials Recovery Facility and as required, with Divert Nova Scotia.
