



VEHICLE / PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS

HRM: October 2019

DISCLAIMER: All figures presented in this report reflect the information held on HRP systems at the time of data extraction and are subject to change without notice.

Summary

- 184 vehicle/pedestrian/bicycle collisions were **reported** in January- October 2019, in Halifax Regional Municipality.
- Of these collisions, 61 involved a bicycle/scooter/skateboard.
- The remaining 123 incidents were strictly vehicle/pedestrian collisions, with 129 pedestrian victims.

- This report presents strictly vehicle/pedestrian collisions and excludes those incidents involving bicycles.
- Scooters/skateboards are recorded under bicycles for purposes of this report.
- Several months in 2019 involved incidents with more than one pedestrian victim.



Trends


Vehicle/pedestrian collisions saw a significant increase in October 2019 over the previous month. It should be noted, however, that incidents decreased by 10 when compared to October of 2018.



The number of incidents in January- October has decreased compared to 2018. In 2018 there were 22 incidents, and so far this year there have been 13 incidents reported.


There have been 36 less collisions reported in 2019 compared to the same time period in 2018.









West Division





Coverage Area**







Collision Types

A total of 26 less vehicle/pedestrian collisions took place in crosswalks in 2019 compared to 2018. However, when comparing to the total number of incidents reported that year, 2018 had incidents occur in a crosswalk 2% more than 2019.

So far in 2019, almost half of incidents (47%), involved vehicles driving straight.

Injuries

90 or 69.75% of the 129 pedestrian victims experienced either no injury or minor injury in January-October of 2019.


There has been 4 pedestrian fatalities thus far in HRM in 2019.

No driver injuries were reported due to collision with pedestrian.


Pedestrian Characteristics

Males accounted for 52 or 59% of drivers involved in vehicle pedestrian collisions in 2019.




Peak Collision Times

Weather & Lighting Conditions

80 or 75% of the reported motor vehicle pedestrian collisions in January-October 2019 occurred during clear and/or sunny weather conditions.

There were 21 collisions which took place during overcast or rain and/or foggy conditions.

78 or 73% of the reported collisions took place during daylight.

66 or 62% of the reported collisions took place during daylight with clear and/or sunny weather conditions.

Note: excludes 16 cases where weather conditions are unknown
