

It's as easy as R-E-C Contest!

1. Eligibility

- a. Contest open to residents of the Halifax Regional Municipality, 19 years of age or older.
- b. Employees of Halifax Regional Municipality and members of their household (whether related or not) are not eligible to participate in the contest.
- c. The Halifax Regional Municipality (the "Municipality") shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Promotion. Failure to provide such proof within a reasonable period of time may result in disqualification. The Municipality reserves the right to disqualify any entrant in its sole discretion should the entrant at any stage supply untruthful, incomplete, inaccurate or misleading personal details and/or information.

2. How to Enter

- a. Each new Client Profile created from July 18, 2018 at 12:01am to August 12, 2018 at 12:00pm (the "Contest Period"), will automatically be entered to win one of five recreation account credits.
- b. Limit of one entry per household.

3. Prize Description

- a. Prizes: four (4) recreation account credits, each valued at fifty dollars (\$50.00)
One (1) recreation account credit, valued at two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00)
- b. Recreation account credits may only be applied to recreation programming and must be used by midnight, June 30, 2019. They cannot be applied to pre-existing program registrations.
- c. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible client profiles created during the contest period.
- d. Prizes must be accepted as awarded. No assignment, transfer, or substitution of prize is permitted, except that the Municipality reserves the right to substitute a prize of comparable or greater value at its sole and absolute discretion, for whatever reason. Prizes have no cash value.

4. Awarding of Prizes

- a. Five potential winners will be chosen by random draw on August 13, 2018 from all eligible client profiles created during the Contest Period.
- b. Each potential winner selected in accordance with these rules will be notified by email or telephone (using the contact information provided as part of the client profile created) to determine if he/she is eligible in the sole discretion of the Municipality.
- c. In the event that any potential winner does not respond to such notification within two (2) business days, or declines a prize for any reason, he/she will be disqualified and have no recourse against the Municipality, the prize will be forfeited and, at the Municipality's discretion and time permitting, an alternate potential winner may be

selected from among all remaining eligible client profiles created during the Contest Period.

- d. To be declared a winner and claim the prize awarded, each potential winner must be eligible in accordance with these Rules and sign a standard Declaration form.
- e. Potential winners will be asked to provide consent for the use of their name, city of residence, and/or photograph for publicity purposes.
- f. The potential winner will have two (2) business days from the date of receipt to return a signed copy of the Declaration and Release form to the Municipality. If he or she does not, he/she will be disqualified and have no recourse against the Municipality, the prize will be forfeited and, at the Municipality's discretion and time permitting, an alternate potential winner may be selected from among all remaining eligible client profiles created during the Contest Period.

5. General Contest Terms & Conditions

- a. In accordance with Section 485 of the Municipal Government Act (MGA), any personal information collected in this form will only be used by Halifax Regional Municipality staff and, if necessary, individuals under service contract with the Halifax Regional Municipality, for purposes relating to recreation services. The Municipality reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual it finds, in its sole discretion, to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest, or to be acting in violation of the Official Rules. Any use of robotic, automatic, programmed, or like entry methods will void all such entries by such methods.
- e. The Municipality reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to cancel, amend, modify or terminate all or any portion of this Contest at any time for any reason without prior notice.
- f. The Municipality reserves the right to amend these Rules as it determines from time to time without any notice.
