



VEHICLE / PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS (HRM: 2014)

January 26, 2015

SUMMARY

There was a total of 262 vehicle/pedestrian collisions reported to police in 2014, with a total of 269 victims in Halifax Regional Municipality.

Of the collisions, 36% did not experience an injury as a result of the collision. Approximately one quarter of victims was in the 21-30 years age range; 56% of victims were female. Males accounted for 65% of drivers involved in vehicle/pedestrian collisions.

Most vehicle/pedestrian collisions occurred Wednesday to Friday, most commonly 3-8pm. There was an average of 15 collisions reported per month during the Spring/Summer period (April to September), compared to an average of 28 collisions per month during Fall/Winter months (January to March and October to December). Weather conditions were clear or sunny at the time of most collisions (57%), although a higher proportion of collisions in November and December took place during rainy and/or foggy weather conditions compared to other months.

Pedestrians in crosswalks accounted for 60% of vehicle/pedestrian collisions. At least one SOT was issued in 46% of collisions.

DETAILED ANALYSIS - VEHICLE / PEDESTRIAN COLLISIONS

INJURIES

84% of pedestrian victims experienced either minor injuries or no injuries in 2014. There were 4 deaths as a result of a vehicle/pedestrian collision.

Two drivers reported minor injuries.

VICTIMS

A higher proportion of victims were female (149, 55.6%) compared to male (119, 44.4%).

The 21-30 age group had the highest proportion of victims (26.3% of victims). This trend is observable amongst males and females.


DRIVERS

Males accounted for a much higher proportion of drivers involved in vehicle/pedestrian collisions.

65% of drivers were 41 years of age or older. Males aged between 41-50 years and females aged between 31-50 years were involved in more collisions compared to drivers in other age ranges (however due to small figures this difference is likely not significant).





PEAK COLLISION TIMES


Late afternoon/evenings (3:00pm-8:00pm) were the most common times for vehicle/pedestrian accidents; with 44% of the collisions occurring during this timeframe.



Fridays saw the largest number of vehicle/pedestrian collisions (50). Fewer collisions occurred on weekends compared to weekdays



Vehicle/pedestrian collisions gradually decreased throughout the months at the beginning of the year, dropping to a low of 11 in both April and May. The number of incidents increased throughout the Fall, peaking in November and December (39 reported incidents in both months).



WEATHER CONDITIONS


The majority of vehicle/pedestrian collisions in 2014 occurred during clear and/or sunny weather conditions (57%) and 28% of collisions took place during rain, fog or wintery conditions.

Clear/sunny conditions were present in 66% of daylight collisions and 44% of collisions that took place when it was dark.

40% of collisions during the dark occurred during rainy/foggy weather conditions.

COLLISION TYPES

Over half of vehicle/pedestrian collisions occurred at crosswalks (156 collisions, 60%). A small proportion (41, 16%) occurred in parking lots.

Two collisions involved buses.

SOTS


In 46% of vehicle/pedestrian collisions at least one SOT was issued; 105 drivers and 16 pedestrians were issued SOTs. A SOT was not issued in 140 collisions.

The outcome of one of the incidents had not been concluded at the time of this report.



Willow Tree Intersection

There were three vehicle/pedestrian collisions at the Willow Tree intersection in 2014. Adverse driving conditions were involved in all three incidents.


Spring Garden Road


EAST DIVISION




Herring Cove Road
