CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

If a rink is approved by the municipality, the community group will be required to enter into a *Community Outdoor Rink Agreement*, with the municipality setting out the terms under which the rink may operate and the responsibilities of the community group with respect to the rink. Including:

- The funds are to be used **only** for the purchase of insurance by the community group for the rink.
- The community group will be required to submit the receipt showing proof of payment and the amount paid.
- Any funds not spent by the community group for the rink insurance must be returned to the municipality
- **NOTE:** Failure to comply with the conditions of the grant may result in ineligibility for any such grant in the following year.
